Communication and Language

Speech and memory games.
Discussion about family, Great Big Book of Family, Family games - recognising that families can be different and we respect everyone.

Using our senses - listening for initial sounds and sounds in words to help us with our writing.

During OUT and ABOUT sessions and topic lessons:
Co-operative play making small and large structures and homes.
Recognising changes in the weather and the seasons.
Developing an understanding about 'our body' and how it changes when we grow.
Showing a concern for living things and the environment.
Who helps us in our local community.
What clubs / groups / societies do we belong to?

Numeracy focus

Counting in order up to 10 or 20.
Counting items in a set and matching items to a numeral.
Using 1:1 correspondence and ensuring an understanding of conservation of number.
Copying and creating patterns.
Time - days of the week, months of the year, positional language.
Beginning to understand addition and subtraction.
